

The Amanda Hat

A fantastically soft and universally attractive hat. Warm, cozy and wonderful for the winter!



What You'll Need:

Needle: US 9 (5.5 mm), 16" (40.6 cm) and 40" (101.6 cm) circular or set of dpns

Yarn: 110 yards (100.5 m) of a soft, single ply heavy worsted weight merino wool yarn (/ used 1/2 skein of Malabrigo Worsted, colorway "Jacinto")**

Notions: stitch marker, scissors, tapestry needle, measuring tape

Finished Dimensions: 8" (20.3 cm) cast on to crown by 10.75" (27.3 cm) across widest part of hat. This size fits a women's head approximately 20-22" (50.8-55.9 cm) around.

Gauge: 4 sts and 5 rows = 1 inch (2.5 cm) in stockinette







Directions:

Cast on 83 stitches loosely. Being careful not to twist, join in the round and place a marker to indicate the beginning of the round.

1. Garter Ribbing: (approx. 1.5"/3.8 cm)

Round 1: purl Round 2: knit

Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 three more times. (A total of 8 rounds)

2. <u>Body of Hat</u>: (approx. 5"/12.7 cm)

Follow the Background Lace pattern (see Background Lace Chart) for 12 rounds. (3 repeats)

Repeat Garter Ribbing two times. (4 rounds)

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3. Crown Decreases: (approx. 2.5"/6.4 cm)

Round 1: (k5, k2tog) around to last 6 sts, k6

Round 2 and all even rounds: knit

Round 3: (k4, k2tog) around

Round 5: (k3, k2tog) around

Round 7: (k2, k2tog) around

Round 9: (k1, k2tog) around


Round 11: (k2tog) around

Round 12: knit

Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail, pull through your last stitch and weave in the ends on the wrong side of the hat. And, yes, there IS supposed to be a line to show where the back of the hat is :D

NOTE: This hat is a bit deep for greater warmth and wearability - and also to cover the ears. If you find this hat to be TOO deep for your head, complete only 2 out of the 3 repeats of the Lace Background pattern between the garter ridges or leave out the second set 4 rounds of garter stitch after the second set of pattern rounds of hat. Some knitters have also opted to do a bit more decreasing at the top of the head. You can continue with the decreases (as established) until you have the desired amount of stitches left on the needle before ending. Lace Background Chart



Stitch Pattern Repeat Outlined in Blue

Round 1: k1, *yo, (sl1, k1, yo, psso over 2 sts)*; repeat *...* to end (124 sts)

Round 2: k1, *drop yo, k2*; repeat *...* to end (83 sts)

Round 3: k2, *yo, (sl1, k1, yo, psso over 2 sts)*; repeat *...* to last st, k1 (**123** sts)

Round 4: k2, *drop yo, k2*; repeat *...* to last st, k1 (83 sts)

Repeat Rounds 1-4 for pattern.

Key
Drop d
(RS) drop the yarn over off the needle
Knit k
(RS) Knit
SI1 K1 Yo Psso2 skyopsso2
(RS) Slip 1 st, knit 1 st, yo, pass the slipped st over both the knit st AND yo
No Stitch x
(RS) No Stitch
Yarn Over yo
(RS) Yarn Over
