


Ritten Scarf
A SuperSoft Scarf Pattern

Materials:

3 skeins of Berroco **Softy** (approx. 312 yards of heavy worsted, super soft yarn) [Violetta colorway used, 52% Dupont Tactel nylon, 48% nylon]

Size: US 10 needles, scissors, tapestry needle, measuring tape

Gauge: not very important to get a specific gauge for this scarf

Abbreviations.

K = knit CO = cast on BO = bind off

Directions:

CO 22 stitches loosely.

Knit every row.

BO loosely. Weave in the two yarn ends at each side of scarf.

Wrap around your face and snuggle deeply within. Enjoy! Purrrrr.......

This is sooo simple, it's mindless. Just keep careful track of your stitches per row...this yarn is easy to drop and very difficult to see if you make a mistake. Take care!
